## PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstracts: Submission of the abstract will be in Microsoft Word format. Selection of papers for presentation will be based on extended abstracts which must include a clear indication of the purpose of research methodology, major results, implications, and key references.

Full-length should be emailed to: iuunsge2021@gmail.com

Title: Must be written in bold, size 14 and centered margin.

Abstracts: 200 to 300 words

**Length of Full Research Paper: Not to exceed 4000 words** 

Margins: 2.5 cm. or 1 inch

Font: Times New Roman, 12 point

Spacing: 1.5 between lines and 2 between paragraphs.

References: With in-text citation in APA style, 6th Edition.

Format: The paper should have a cover page giving title, author's name, complete address, telephone number, and email ID of the author. In case of co-authors, the details need to be mentioned. Correspondence will be sent to the first-named author unless otherwise indicated. The second page should contain the title and an abstract. It should also include up to five keywords about the paper. No other page should carry the author's name. The paper should begin from the third page.

All abstracts will be peer reviewed and evaluated on the basis of originality, research rigor, relevance to the seminar, and contribution to the theory and practice.

#### **Publication**

- ★ Seminar abstracts will be published in e-abstract book.
- ★ Selected full papers shall be published in an edited volume with ISBN number published by School of Liberal Arts, IMS Unison University, Dehradun (Extra charges may be applicable for publication)

### **RULES FOR PARTICIPATION**

- **★** No abstract or full paper shall be accepted after the last date of submission.
- \* Registration is mandatory on confirmation of acceptance of abstract, with the payment of required fees to be deposited in the bank account. Only registered participants will be allowed to take part in the National Seminar.
